**Introduction:**

**Prophecy** The spiritual ability to speak forth the mind and counsel of God. Prophecy is God communicating His thoughts and intents to humanity

**Prophetic message:** Can be preached truth, prayed burden, or encouraging word, but it is only prophetic if it brings its generation into the knowledge of the heart of God for that time.

**Prophetic Impressions for 2008**

1. This year, 2008 will be a year of new spiritual beginnings(Isa 43:18-19)
2. This will be a year of increased personal revelation (1 Cor 2:9-10)
3. This is a year for God's people to possess the spiritual Gates (Praise and Worship—Intercession)
4. This is a year of unrepresented creativity
5. In 2008 God is raising up life-guards and rescuers in the church

(Isaiah 60) "Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you. See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the LORD rises upon you and his glory appears over you.

**Prophetic Impressions for 2009**

**1. This is a year to awaken your spirit and give ourselves to understanding (redeeming) the times (Eph 5:11-20)**

(Eph 5:11-20) Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. {12} For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. {13} But everything exposed by the light becomes visible, {14} for it is light that makes everything visible. (14) This is why it is said: "Wake up, O sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." {15} Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, {16} making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. {17} Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

(1 Chr 12:32) men of Issachar, who understood the times and knew what Israel should do--200 chiefs, with all their relatives under their command;

(Luke 12:56) Hypocrites! You know how to interpret the appearance of the earth and the sky. How is it that you don't know how to interpret this present time?

## 2. This will be a year of testing and shaking which will result in a divine distinction and separation. (Heb 12:26-29)

### # 9 is the number of finality or judgment

- *Nine* persons "**stoned**."

### Why is the Lord allowing the shaking

#### a) God is doing this, to bring a distinction between the righteous (the year of separation)

(Heb 12:26-29) At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, "Once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens." {27} The words "once more" indicate the removing of what can be shaken--that is, created things--so that what cannot be shaken may remain. {28} Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, {29} for our "God is a consuming fire."

#### b) The Second reason that the Lord is allowing this is to create a dependence on Him and less on the dollar

(Deuteronomy 8:3) And He humbled you and allowed you to hunger and fed you with manna, which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you recognize and personally know that man does not live by bread only, but man lives by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of the Lord.

#### c) The third reason is to eliminate false securities ( government) and more on Him

## 3. This will be a year of increased dependence and anointing in the Holy Spirit (Joel 2:24)

(Joel 2:24) The threshing floors shall be full of wheat, And the vats shall overflow with new wine and oil.  
(Joel 2: 28 – 29) And it shall come to pass afterward That I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your old men shall dream dreams, Your young men shall see visions. And also on My menservants and on My maidservants I will pour out My Spirit in those days.

## 4. This is a time of unlimited creativity and artistic potential (Exo 31:2-5)

(Exo 31:2-5) "See, I have chosen Bezalel (in the shadow of God) son of Uri, (my light) the son of Hur, (liberty) of the tribe of Judah, {3} and I have filled him with the Spirit of God, with skill, ability and knowledge in all kinds of crafts-- {4} to make artistic designs for work in gold, silver and bronze, {5} to cut and set stones, to work in wood, and to engage in all kinds of craftsmanship.

## 5. This is a time to know what you believe, to increase in love and faithfulness, and to trust the Lord with all your heart. (Prov 3:1-17)

(Prov 3:1-17) My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart, {2} for they will prolong your life many years and bring you prosperity. {3} Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. {4} Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man. {5} Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; {6} in all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make your paths straight. {7} Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil. {8} This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones. {9} Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops; {10} then your barns will be filled to overflowing, and your vats will brim over with new wine. {11} My son, do not despise the Lord's discipline and do not resent his rebuke, {12} because the LORD disciplines those he loves, as a father the son he delights in. {13} Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding, {14} for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold. {15} She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her. {16} Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor. {17} Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace.

Teaching and commands	Prolong life and prosperity
Love and faithfulness	Favor with God and Man
Trust	God will make your paths straight
Fear the Lord	Health and nourishment
Honor the Lord with your wealth (firstfruits)	Abundance

- This is a time for developing TRUST
- This is a time to overcome by faith and not be overcome by fear (1 John 5:4-5)

(1 John 5:4-5) for everyone born of God **overcomes** the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. {5} Who is it that overcomes the world? Only he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

- **nikaō nik-ah'-o** to gain victory conquer, overcome (Rev 2:7) (Rev 2:11) (Rev 2:17) (Rev 2:26) (Rev 3:5) (Rev 3:12) (Rev 3:21) (Rev 17:14) (Rev 21:7)

## 6. This is a year for proper divine alignments and agreements in unity (Matthew 18:19)

### The Power of Agreement

- As Believers, when we study the benefits of praying in "agreement" or praying in "agreement" with one another, we realize that we become a mighty force for the Kingdom of God.

- Using the *Amplified Version of the Bible*, we notice how praying and being in agreement creates the unity and sound as does a symphony:

(Matthew 18:19) "Again I tell you, if two of you on earth agree (harmonize together, make a symphony together) about whatever (anything and everything) they may ask, it will come to pass and be done for them by My Father in Heaven."

- The word *agree* in Greek is *sumphoneo* and it means "to be harmonious, (to be) in one accord and in unity."

## 7. This is a year of increase in Kingdom justice through intercessory prayer (Luke 18:1-8)

### The main events in the parable

1. There was an unjust judge in a certain city who did not fear God nor man.
2. There came a persistent widow pleading for justice against her adversary.
3. The judge would not grant her justice.
4. The widow persisted in the pleading for justice night and day.
5. The judge changes his mind and begins to consider granting the widow the justice due.
6. The judge was not motivated by the sense of justice, but by the need to not be troubled and wearied by the widow's persistent pleading for justice.
7. The widow received her justice speedily.

### The main truth in the parable

1. Speedy justice is released through the night and day cry of His elect.
2. The Lord bears long with the elect.
3. Justice is released in the form of avenging (vengeance).
4. The Son of man will come.
5. The Son of man desires to find faith on the earth when He returns.

### The main themes of the parable (v.1)

1. Men always ought to pray
2. Not lose heart
3. In the context of highly unfavorable circumstances
4. God will avenge His elect with speedy justice.

### The main challenge from the parable

1. Hear what the unjust judge said.
2. Shall the Son of man find faith on the earth when He returns?
